Practice the hard conversation before it happens for real

A virtual crisis table where AI colleagues push back, your decisions have consequences, and the lessons come from real industrial failures — not a made-up plant.

Ask the seat. Then sit at the table. Real experts still own the deepest answers.

Classroom training

Slides. Workshops. Role-play with peers.

Useful — until the real moment arrives.

Then none of it felt like this.

The real moment

Smoke on the board.

Three people talking at once.

Production pressure vs safety.

Someone has to decide.

Table lets you practice that — safely.

Why this is justified

When something goes wrong, the hard part is people — not one technical fact.

Operations

Wants the unit back online

Safety

Wants certainty before anyone moves

Permit desk

Will not sign what they cannot defend

Real experts — human ground truth

One line to remember

Voices help you **ask the right seat**.

Table **makes you decide** when several seats collide.

Real experts **still own** the deepest answers.

Why this beats the alternatives

Beyond Soft Skills alone

- Truth from verified courses — not free invention
- Seat briefs from Voices — not generic tropes
- Teaching stories coach — never rewrite the plant
- Clear Situation Room product for customers

Beyond Voices alone

- Several seats collide at once
- You decide — with consequences
- Full score + consequence tree
- Muscle memory for crisis leadership

Why this is different

More real than a workshop

Several stakeholders push; your choices change what happens next

Safer than learning on the job

Practice the hard call without risking people or production

More trustworthy than generic AI

Fed by verified lessons and role seats — not free invention

Clearer than a name stack

Study → ask the seat (Voices) → act at the table (Table)

First pilot — keep it concrete

Oil & gas first: isolation, hot work, nitrogen-related hazards

Four seats: Maintenance Lead · Field Operator · Permit Coordinator · HSE Advisor

Two practice scenarios on the Soft Skills engine

Honesty rule: every plant fact must trace to a verified lesson

Teaching stories may whisper a coach tip — never rewrite the plant
